Family Suite

Resolved Issues

New User Registration

Fixed: State/Region Values Missing After New User Registrations Approved

Previously, after registration was approved for a newly added family, the system did not update values in the **State/Region** field in the family record. We fixed this issue.

Family Directory

Fixed: Some Controls in Member Details Are Slow to Respond

Some customer reported experiencing poor response times in **Member Details** when performing certain operations, such as clicking the **Edit Details** button and adding a language. We fixed this issue.

Ministry Scheduler

Fixed: Page Buttons on Multi-Page Ministers Grid Not Working

Previously, the page buttons on the **Available Ministers** grid did not work as expected. As a result, users could not jump to specific pages in a multi-paged grid. We fixed this issue.

Religious Education

Fixed: Classes Selected in Dashboard's Classes Panel Sometimes Fail to Load

Some users reported that when selecting a class in the **Classes** panel on the Religious Ed dashboard, the system displayed this message:

```
No Classes exist (for selected term)
```

We fixed this issue. When a class is selected in the **Classes** panel, its data now loads successfully.

IQ

Fixed: Wrong Results Provided by Queries with Mixed Religious Ed and Family Directory Data

Users reported that queries containing a mix of Religious Education and Family Directory data do not always return correct results. We fixed this issue.

Fixed: Multi-Part Identifier Could Not Be Bound Error

Users reported sometimes experiencing this error when running a query:

```
Multi-Part Identifier Could Not Be Bound
```

We determined that this rare error occurred when certain Religious Education fields, such as **Grade Level** and **Student ID**, were combined with Family and Member fields that were added to a query in a specific order. We fixed this issue. Note that as a result of the fix, we made the following changes:

- Father and mother fields were moved from the main **Religious Education** group. You can find these fields in a new group, labeled **Parent Info**.
- The following student fields were moved from the main **Religious Education** group:
 - ❖ **Grade Level**
 - ❖ **Student Notes**
 - ❖ **Student DUID**

You can find these fields in a new group, labeled **Student Info**.

Existing queries that use the moved fields continue to work as expected. Additionally, existing queries that combined the Religious Education fields with the Family and Member fields now work without error.

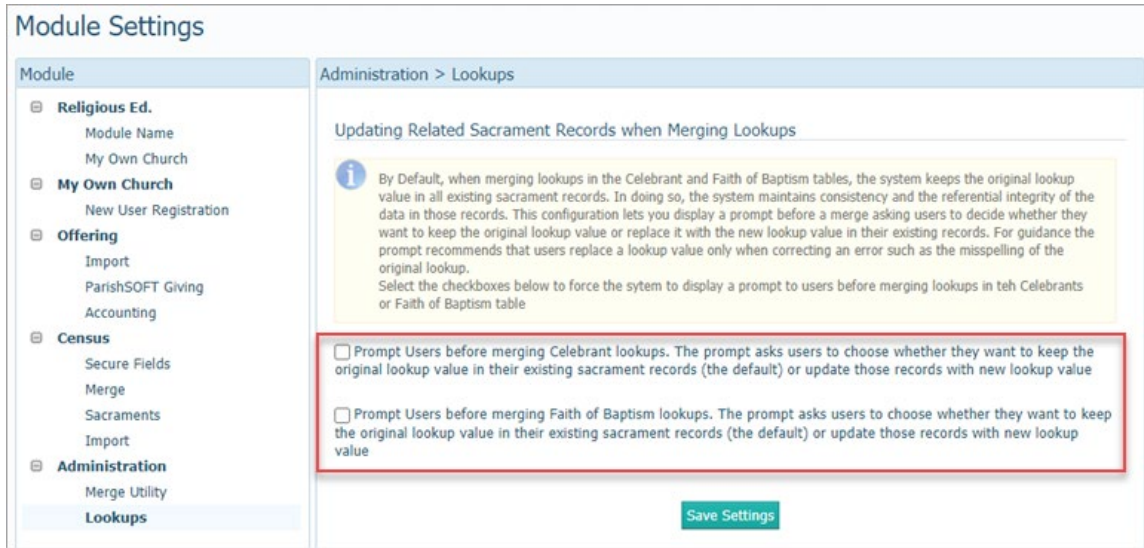

Prompt Configuration Options Added for Merging Celebrant and Faith of Baptism Lookups



We added a **Lookups** page to the **Administration** group on the **Module Settings** page. As shown in the following illustration, the page contains two options a diocesan administrator can select to force the system to prompt users at merge time to choose between keeping the original lookup value in existing Celebrant or Faith of Baptism records or updating existing records with the new (merged) lookup.



Note that, by default, both options are not selected. Therefore when Celebrant and Faith of Baptism lookups are merged, the default behavior is not to prompt user to make a choice and not to update existing sacrament records with the new (merged) lookup value. If you want to let users choose the merge behavior for these lookups, select one or both checkboxes.
